Your Local Representative Must Be Contract Free

As a Local Executive Director, it is very important that any contract you enter into with a commercial concern must be non-competitive with the Miss Kansas Organization's (MKO) State Sponsors. It must carry a clause to the effect that they cannot use the name, photograph or title of your Local Representative in any advertising before, and including the night of the State Finals.

Furthermore, this clause must also stipulate that should your Local Representative become Miss Kansas, they can no longer use her name, title or photograph in any advertising whatsoever. These stipulations must be included in any contract or agreement between a business and your Local Representative, as it is consistent with your Local Titleholder's Candidate Contract, declaring that she is contract-free.

Additionally, MKO Policy prohibits a finalist in the Miss Kansas Competition from receiving national publicity prior to the State Competition unless previously approved by MKO.
