THE JANET K. MCENTARFER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IN EDUCATION AND SERVICE

The Award

The Janet K. McEntarfer Memorial Scholarship in Education and Community Service was implemented for women competing at the state level of competition pursuing a degree (undergraduate, masters or higher) in education. This award is open to those pursuing careers as classroom teachers, special area teachers, (i.e., art, physical education, music, etc.), school counselors, school psychologists, school nurses and school administrators.

A new application must be submitted each year, along with an official transcript. If you are a high school senior, you must also submit a letter of intent to major in the field of education from your school counselor with your high school transcript.

Guidelines for the Award

The award will be granted annually to women competing in the Miss Kansas Competition who are declared education majors. The scholarship committee will review applications for the scholarship and will award one or more scholarships per year depending upon the qualifications of the applicants and availability of funds.

Applicants will be considered for the award based on a combination of factors including, but not limited to, grade point average (high school and college/university), community service, and extracurricular activities.
