SERVANT LEADERSHIP AWARD

Description:

Leadership styles vary greatly, with vastly different examples of leaders seen in the news headlines daily. As a titleholder, you are a leader in your community. With each level of the Miss America Program, your opportunities to lead will naturally expand to a wider audience. As you prepare for those experiences, consider the following:

- What does it mean to be a servant leader?
- What qualities are required to be a servant leader?
- What examples of servant leaders have you observed, either in person or from a distance, and how do you know they are/were effective leaders?
- In what ways are you leading in this manner currently, and how do you plan to cultivate stronger servant leadership attributes?

Requirements:

- * The Servant Leadership Award is available to any young woman competing at this year's Miss Kansas Competition. The award recipient will receive a \$1500 scholarship and a \$500 expense grant to assist in funding facilitation, promotion, and support of their Social Impact Initiative.
- * Applicants are to submit an Essay (described below) along with the Application Certification & Narrative (page two of this document).
- * Essay Description
Submissions will be judged on how clearly the recipient articulates their understanding of the qualities of a servant leader and demonstrates their own possession of these characteristics with specific examples through thoughtful response to each of the questions referenced above.

Correct basic grammar, punctuation, spelling, and sentence structure are expected in an essay of 500 words or less. Essays must be typed, using 8 1/2 x 11 paper, Times-New Roman 12-point type, and double-spaced. The candidate's name and title must be included at the top of each page.
- * Applications will be judged by a separate panel of judges, with the award recipient being announced during competition week.
- * Applications will not be returned to the applicant and all submissions become the sole property of the Miss Kansas Scholarship Organization. Excerpts or the entirety of a submission may be used for Miss Kansas Scholarship Organization marketing, promotions, or other such purposes.
